




1. CHOOSE YOUR APPRENTICE ROLE (ONLINE)

To get started, simply research which role suits you best, and register your interest. We'll get in touch to let you know what happens next.

Remember, you don't need work experience for our apprentice roles, or a coding background to go for a technology role. Please also review the profile for each role before applying. You can only apply to one programme in a six-month period, so it's important to research the role and review its eligibility criteria before you apply.

2. VALUES & MINDSET ASSESSMENT (ONLINE)

This assessment is untimed and takes approximately 16 minutes to complete. It will measure your workplace behaviours and how they align to Barclays Values and Mindset.

Lots of employers use these kinds of tools, so whether you are applying for Barclays or not, you can practice them through this <u>link</u>.

3. GENERAL ABILITY TEST (ONLINE)

This measures your general cognitive ability, in particular your deductive, inductive and numerical reasoning ability.

It features multiple choice question content,
(Foundation Apprentices) or real-life work situations
in an interactive format (Higher Apprentices).
It's a timed 10-12 minute assessment
consisting of 10-12 questions.

4. INTERVIEW

(VIRTUAL OR IN-PERSON)

The interview will last up to 90 minutes and you will be asked to give recent examples of when you have demonstrated a specific behaviour or experienced a specific situation.

It is recommended that you remind yourself of your key achievements from the last 12 – 18 months to draw upon. Using the <u>STAR method</u> can guide the structure of your answers to a question and can help you provide the interviewers with as much relevant detail as possible to showcase your suitability for the role.

5. OUTCOME & FEEDBACK

(PHONE)

Following the completion of your interview, you'll receive a call to discuss your offer outcome and feedback.

If you are successful, we'll offer you a place on one of our Apprenticeships and start planning for you to join our team. If you're not successful right away, you'll have our support to try again.
